“Nestled between Burgundy and Switzerland, mountainous Jura is hailed for fab landscapes, scattered vineyards and local grapes that are very rare elsewhere.

The signature white variety of this lush and green region is Savagnin – perfect raw material for beautifully oxidated, bone-dry vin jaune that has been aged on the veil of yeast just like sherry. The magic of these wines is unbeatable!

But Savagnins can also be standard varietal wines of irresistible energy.

Jura’s supple, brightly fruity red wines of Trousseau and Poulsard grapes are unique as well.

The first produces poised wines that soar from the glass with red berries, flowers and earthy vibes while the latter results in light and delicate yet complex red wines with echoes from woodland.”

Pure Bojo at its most beautiful

Since the price tags of great Burgundy wines have sky-rocketed in recent years, it's a delight to serve delish terroir wines from Bourgogne and Beaujolais artisans such as Philippe Pacalet.

Nephew to Beaujolais natural wine legend Marcel Lapiere, Pacalet saw already 20 years ago the painfully staggering land prices in Burgundy and understood he had no option but rent vineyards on Côte de Nuits and Côte de Beaune. Besides these Burgundy regions, he grows grapes in Beaujolais and Chablis, as well as in Côte-Rôtie and Cornas in Northern Rhône.

Pacalet's repertoire caters for every taste from lighter joie de vivre Bojos to red charmeurs from iconic Bourgogne villages and to superb 1er Cru Chablis. Embracing a largely non-interventionist approach, Philippe ferments grape juices with natural yeasts and without sulphur, letting his wines blossom out during slow ageing in oak barrels.

Quaff a glass and be charmed by purity!

Beaujolais has its unique identity, yet the way Brun makes wine pays homage to the traditions of Bourgogne – highlighting finesse, freshness and great backbone.

But compared to Burgundy today, it’s not only you who’ll love Beaujolais. Your wallet will, too.”

Loire

Quilt of climates and grapes

“For a wine region in Northern France, temperate Loire climate is pretty pleasant with mild winters, less draught and fewer extreme temperatures. Yet flowing over 1 000 kilometres from beautifully rural Auvergne highlands to the Atlantic Ocean, the Loire River offers such a vast array of growing conditions that one lifetime may not be enough for exploring all.

But it is enough for discovering super fresh and bone-dry Ocean-influenced Muscadet, lovely Cabernet Franc reds of Chinon, bubbly Chenin Blanc delights from Vouvray as well as continental-climate Sauvignons from the most coveted villages, Sancerre and Pouilly-Fumé. Besides these darlings, the Loire Valley is home to quirky grapes such as Grolleau, Romorantin and Gros Plant.

Natural wine drinkers love the Loire – and no wonder. Nearly 70 percent of the vineyards are organically or sustainably farmed, and this figure is on the rise. Loire is also packed with vigneronns that swear in the name of authenticity and non-interventionist approach in winemaking”

GERMANY

The Magic of The Rhein

It goes without saying that Rheingau belongs to the vocabulary – and heart – of German wine lovers. For many, this region represents the most majestic expression of the Riesling grape. Stronger, steelier, sinewier and drier than in the Mosel. But at least as wonderful.

Rheinhessen, in turn, has seen such a renaissance in quality over the past two decades that it doesn't cease to amaze us. Long gone are the days when the name Rheinhessen was primarily linked to bulk white wine in people's minds. The new winemaker generation has done miracles to this innovative region that we know today also for exciting value-for-money red, sparkling & rosé.

North of Rheinhessen and Rheingau, their lesser known neighbour Mittelrhein is a mild-climate region of spectacular landscapes and wine discoveries – if you happen to find them from this not widely exported wine region. Ratzenberger is a the Mouthwatering name to many.

As Isabella Pelizzatti Perego from ARPEPE – the best winery of Alpine Valtellina region – visited Apotek, she suggested we pair one of their red wines with our whitefish ceviche.

Against all odds, the combo was superb!

How can such a tannic grape as Nebbiolo perform so well with lime cured low-fat fish?

To be honest, the Alpine Nebbiolo – locally called Chiavennasca – has very little to do with the austere character of young Barolos and Barbarescos.

In Valtellina Valley at the foot of the Alps, especially at the skilled hands of the Pelizzatti family, this grape makes delicately oaked red wines that are fresh, elegant and groovy to drink.

Rioja and Ribera del Duero have been on people's lips as long as I remember, but Spain is so much more than these beloved wine regions and the Tempranillo grape.

Thinking about Spanish wines make me reminisce of...

*The rocky fjords of Rías Baixas.
The smell of pine in the Catalan backlands.
The windmills of Terra Alta by night.
That quirky fizz of the Basque Country.
The rising Garnachas from West of Madrid.
Oh, and those volcanic gems from the Canary Islands.*

In today's Spain freshness is the key. As our climate turns warmer, many wine estates in hot parts of the country plant on higher slopes where the nights are still cooler – and picked grapes fresher.

Also modern approach and development in winemaking have resulted in better wines than ever. Now this renowned red wine country dazzles with fascinating whites as well.

At the same time it takes enormous pride in its own, indigenous/autochthonous grapes. Did you know Spain is also the leader in organic and biodynamic viticulture / grape growing?
